


STANDARD OVERLAY OR FULL OVERLAY. WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?


For starters, there are two categories of cabinet doors: standard and full overlay.

A full overlay door just means that the door or drawer front covers most of the cabinet frame. This seamless appearance produces a more modern look.

A standard overlay allows 1-1/16" exposure of the cabinet frame, creating a more traditional look.

When the cabinet door has a center panel that is higher than the surrounding wood, it is a raised panel door.

RECESSED PANEL DOOR

A cabinet door with a center panel that is slightly depressed is referred to as a recessed panel. A beveled trim in the recessed panel adds a touch of elegance.

MITERED DOOR

Raised and recessed panel door joints are mitered, which conceals the joinery, producing a seamless and elegant picture frame design.

SLAB DOOR

A cabinet door that is neither raised nor recessed and with no decorative elements

SHAKER DOOR

Our Shaker-style cabinets are distinguished by a five-piece door with a recessed center panel. These door styles include 650, 420 and 410.










GET AWAY FROM IT ALL






INSPIRED BY THE SEA




A BRIDGE TO LOVE















LIFE IS A BEACH—A GOLDEN MAPLE-COLORED SANDY ONE

The Right Amount of Water


Overwatering is one of the most common reasons a plant doesn't thrive. To find out if your plant needs water, stick your finger about an inch into the soil, close to the edge of the pot. If it's dry, it's time to water!

Proper Drainage

Make sure your pots have drainage holes, to help prevent root rot. Another way to help is to put a layer of pebbles at the bottom of the pot, about ½-inch to 1-inch thick, to keep water away from the roots.

The Right Lighting

Be sure to read the label of the plant when you purchase it to find out the best lighting (and watering) for it. It will usually be either full sun, partial sun or shade.


Picking the right paint color for your living space can seem daunting. Here are some guidelines to help you pick the best color for your space and create the feeling you're looking to achieve.

FIND INSPIRATION. Don't pick your color for the room first. You need to draw inspiration from the pieces that will be in that room, such as a piece of furniture, a rug or a favorite piece of artwork.

DON'T OVERSATURATE. Keep a balance with a neutral base palette and vibrant, colorful accents. Typically, you want to keep your paint mainly neutral and accent with colorful furniture and accessories, or maybe an accent wall. However, if you really want brightly colored walls, make sure the furniture and accessories in the room are neutral colors to balance it out.

USE TESTERS. Paint large swatches of different colors on a wall before making your final decision on color and sheen. Leave them for up to a week so you can experience them at different times of day and with different lighting.

ADDING MORE COLOR. Once you have your basic paint picked out, you might decide the room is not colorful enough for you. An easy way to add more color is to play up monochromatic color schemes by adding an accent color that is a cooler or warmer version of the initial color. Using a color wheel will make this much easier. Another technique using a color wheel is picking a complementary color—colors that are across from each other create a very intense and vibrant feeling when used together.
